1 cup flour 2 tsp oil 2 Tbsp cream of tartar 1 cup water 1/2 cup salt Food coloring

Add ingredients to pan. Add food coloring to desired color. More can be added as needed.

Cook over low heat, stirring constantly until thickened. Let cool. Knead together. Have fun. Store in plastic container.
