MISSION SERVICE IN PUERTO RICO

In September of 2019, Vic and Nancy Miller embarked on a missions trip to Puerto Rico with the Mennonite Disaster Service (MDS). They spent two weeks working on projects in areas of the island that had been ravaged by Hurricane Maria earlier that summer. Their first week of service started in the city of Ponce, where they worked on a home devastated by the hurricane. As seen in the picture below, Vic and Nancy worked on shoring up the foundation of a home, fashioning cinder blocks. Nancy recalls the extreme heat and humidity they had to contend with while doing this heavy work. She also recalls how grateful the family was for the tireless work they were doing in very difficult conditions. This particular household was occupied by a man left with his two daughters to raise in the aftermath of the storm.

On their second week they headed into a more mountainous region to reconstruct an entire home that was completely destroyed by the hurricane. The weather was just slightly cooler in the mountains. This project was headed by Johan Zimmerman, an engineer/architect from Harrisonburg, Virginia... better known as the "JZ Crew". Nancy notes while working on this house, they had to share living quarters and one bathroom with 15 people. They all remained good friends after that experience.

Nancy shared that she met a person who was in on the ground floor of developing the 10,000 Villages organization, sharing the vision of communities selling their hand-made items to generate money.

Nancy and Vic use the words, "a beautiful country and beautiful people" to describe their experience in Puerto Rico. They hope to return some day.


